ITC Infotech lends support to an interdisciplinary team of researchers from John Hopkins University for an App developed as part of the University's COVID Control Study

'COVID Control – A Johns Hopkins University Study', is aimed at locating potential COVID-19 clusters in the US

Tracking the spread of the coronavirus is an ongoing challenge. But researchers at Johns Hopkins University are conducting a study that uses an app to collect information that can help localize potential COVID – 19 clusters and flare-ups.

COVID Control – A Johns Hopkins University Study, JHSPH approved IRB study (IRB number IRB00012283), is a new surveillance tool for COVID-19 based on self-reported body temperatures and, optionally, other symptoms, from users around the country using a user-friendly app. By using spatial science analytics applied to these data they will identify anomalous increases in body temperatures and generate real-time, pre-clinical, risk estimates of potential COVID-19 outbreaks.



The project team from Johns Hopkins is working with ITC Infotech's Digital Experience (DX) team to further enhance the user interface and user experience (UI/UX) of the COVID Control data collection App. ITC Infotech's DX experts are helping the team from Johns Hopkins fast track UI/UX enhancements to drive higher adoption by introducing more user-friendly features.

This impacted the recovery momentum, particularly in the months of July'20 and August'20 and posed significant challenges to sales operations. The situation continues to improve with the progressive easing of restrictions from Sept'20. Against this backdrop, the Company recorded a strong recovery in revenue across all operating segments.


